It is this thesis -- that Kissinger was a man of the Cold War and a captive of his time -- that serves to mute Suri's judgments about controversial Nixon-era policies. Suri also attempts to illuminate the impact of Kissinger's German Jewish identity on his foreign policy vision. At one level, it was simply instrumental: Kissinger's early career was built on his ability to translate German society for Americans. Print this page. *Nixon and Kissinger: Partners in Power*. Kissinger's many gifts, rarely alluded to, allowed him to make fast friends, at home and abroad, with prominent intellectuals, politicians and statesmen. Kissinger made grievous mistakes - and it is of course the historian's obligation to record and interpret them - but this scarcely legitimates the brutish portrayal of Dallek's intemperate and biased jeremiad. It is time for a more nuanced and balanced book to be written about Kissinger that explains Nixon's reliance on him both before and after Watergate.
